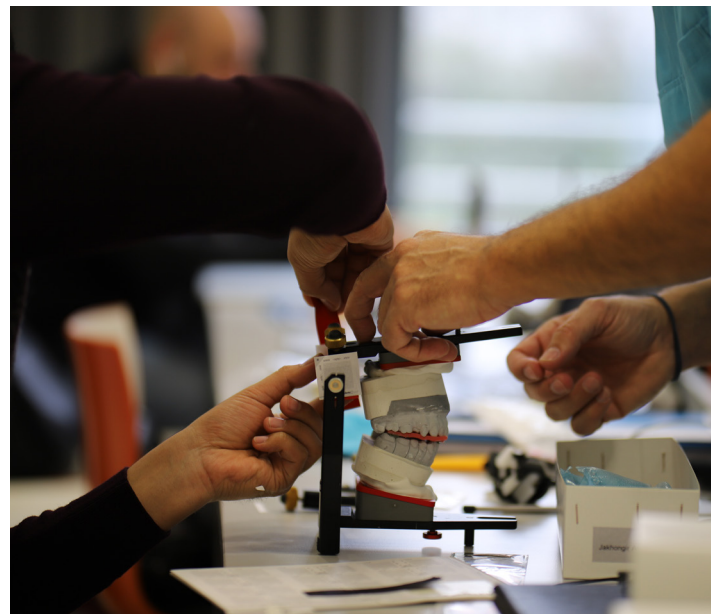

- Neurologic exam + Demonstration
- Occlusogram: intraoral application and reading
- Guidance painting according to occlusogram marks
- BruxChecker (when prepared in advance by participant)
- Photo Documentation
- Importing the full documentation into the Gamma Browser

Instrumental protocol

- Hinge-axis identification and condylography
- True-Hinge axis face bow mounting
- RP recording and proofing and lower cast mounting
- Photos of the casts
- Instrumental analysis in the articulator
- Determination of the anterior guidance
- Occlusal protocol, static
- Occlusal protocol, dynamic
- CPM, mechanic
